- * Board approved the April 12, 2015 General Session Board Meeting Minutes and Architectural Reports from 3/10/15-4/10/15.
- * Board accepted the March 31, 2015 financial statement as submitted.

- * Board approved to place a lien on APN #623-582-13 for outstanding assessments and applicable charges.
- * Board approved the Executive Finance Committee report approving Management to contact the Association's legal counsel if necessary regarding improvements being made at an address without architectural approval.
- * Board approved a proposal from Villa Park Landscape for the items generated from the April 16, 2015 landscape drive, for a cost of \$1,552.50.
- * Board approved to approve a proposal from Armstrong/Robitaille/Riegle (A/R/R), the Association's current insurance company, to renew the Association's insurance policies for D&O, Liability, Property, Fidelity and Worker's Compensation for an annual premium of \$9,868.00.
- * Board approved a proposed budget for 2015/2016 increasing assessments \$5.00/month from \$68.00/month to \$73.00/month starting July 1, 2015.
- * Board decided to leave David Shafer and Rich Schlesinger on the Architectural Committee and not appoint two other homeowners to replace them.
