### JUNE 13, 2016 BOARD MEETING RECAP

- Board approved the May 18, 2016 General Session Meeting Minutes and Architectural Report from 5/11/16-6/6/16.
- Board accepted the Executive Finance Committee Report regarding placing a lien on a delinquent account that took place between the May and June meetings.
- Board accepted the May 31, 2016 financial statement as submitted.
- Board approved to place liens on the following delinquent accounts: APN #632-522-17, APN #623-601-36, APN #623-622-03 and APN #623-543-19.
- Board accepted the resignation from Gosia Etaati and appointed Jim Griffin to the landscape committee.
- Board requested Management to draft a survey that will be sent to the homeowners to see what they think about perimeter vinyl fences.
