# ANNUAL MEETING AND ELECTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND AVCA DELEGATE

The Annual Meeting and Election for the Board of Directors and AVCA Delegate is scheduled for June 5, 2018 after the regular Board meeting. All five (5) Board members are up for election since we did not achieve quorum last year. The three (3) Board members receiving the highest votes will serve for two (2) years and the other two (2) Board members will serve for one (1) year. If you haven't sent in your ballot, please do so we can make sure to have quorum to hold the election. Make sure you place your ballot in the white envelope, then place the white envelope in the yellow envelope and don't forget to write your name, address and sign the outside of the yellow envelope to ensure your ballot is valid. ### **MAY 7, 2018 BOARD MEETING RECAP**

- Board approved the March 7, 2018 General Session Meeting minutes and Architectural Submittal Report from 3/3/18-4/25/18.
- Board accepted the February 28, 2018 & March 31, 2018 financial statements.
- Board approved to roll over the reserve CD maturing on 6/15/18, for a term of 12 months, and at the highest interest rate available.
- Board approved a proposed budget for the fiscal year of 2018-2019, keeping assessments that same at 73.00/month.
- Board approved a proposal from Villa Park Landscape for items generated from the March 15, 2018 landscape drive, for a cost of \$2,016.00 and a proposal for items generated from the April 19, 2018 landscape drive, for a cost of \$815.00.
- Board postponed further discussion on a proposal from Villa Park Landscape to either trim down the Ficus vines along the wall on Shorecliff or remove/replace them altogether until the June 5, 2018 meeting, so the Board can drive by and take a look at the entire wall.
- Board approved a proposal from Villa Park Landscape to install a pressure regulator behind an address, for a cost of \$1,170.00 and another proposal to cut roots from Pine trees along the side of a house and install a root barrier, for a cost of \$1,834.00.
- Board approved to allow a homeowner to install a wrought iron fence in front of their home to enclose a patio as long as it doesn't exceed 36" in height from the ground.
- Board postponed further discussion of revising the Architectural Guidelines and discussion on lattice being allowed on top of block walls until the June 5, 2018 meeting.
- Board requested Management let City know that they think "No Parking" signs should be installed along Oakleigh, between Eastwing & Ridgecrest, and on the street on the side where the fire hydrant is located, to keep people from parking on both sides of the street.


